CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T.35N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 9 bears S. 46°33'57" W., a distance of 2,360.41 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: R. Jeff Williams and Dessa K. Williams
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.041 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.572 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 9, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 225 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch casing via a submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to two single family residences on Lots 4 and 5, Block 57 of the Meadow Valley Ranchos Unit 3 located within portions of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, T.35N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
