CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James C. Holland, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 30, T.28N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 30 bears S. 77° W., a distance of 2,668.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: James C. Holland
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: irrigation
Amount of appropriation: *1.54 c.f.s., but not to exceed 48.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 4, 1990

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

16.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 30, T.28N., R.32E., M.D.B.&M. 16.0 acres total.

*The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 27746, Certificate 12534 shall not exceed 1.54 c.f.s. and 78.0 acre-feet annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
