CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, L. Rey Flake, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through an improved spring, pipelines, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.5S., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 4, T.6S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 62°49' W., a distance of 57,100.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: H.H. Land and Cattle Company
Source: Cottonwood Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: *0.0078 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 900 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: **February 12, 1996

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Cottonwood Spring by means of a 15 feet long, 2 inch diameter, perforated, galvanized pipe driven into the bank, thence through a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch poly pipe 500 feet in length to a 500 gallon water trough where 900 head of cattle water within the following:

T.2S., R.63E., portions of Sections 11, 12, 15; Sections 13, 22 through 26, 35, and 36 (unsurveyed).

T.2S., R.64E., portions of S $\frac{1}{2}$ Sections 7, 8, and 9; portion of Sections 15, 22, 23, 25, and 26; Sections 16 through 21, and 27 through 36.

T.2S., R.65E., Section 31, portion of Sections 29, 30, 32, and 33.

T.3S., R.63E., Sections 1, 2, 11 through 14, 12 through 26, 35, and 36.

T.3S., R.64E., all Sections.

T.3S., R.65E., Sections 4 through 9, 16 through 21, and 28 through 33.

T.4S., R.63E., Sections 1, 2, 11 through 14, 23 through 26, 35, and 36.

T.4S., R.64E., all Sections.

T.2S., R.63E., portion of Section 14.

T.2S., R.64E., portion of Section 10.


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 52103, Certificate 13775, Permit 52104, Certificate 13776, Permit 52105, Certificate 13777, Permit 52106, Certificate 13778, Permit 52107, Certificate 13779, Permit 52108, Certificate 13780, Permit 52109, Certificate 13781, Permit 52112, Certificate 13782, and any certificates issued under Permits 52113, 52114, 52115, and 52118 shall not exceed sufficient water for 900 head of cattle.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 3270, Certificate 269. The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of Permit 52113 on August 23, 1996.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
