CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Mike Compston, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Urriaga Spring through an improved spring and pipeline to stockwatering troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 11, T.14N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NW corner of said
Section 11 bears N. 21°53'39" W., a distance of
1,322.57 feet situated in Carson City, State of
Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: Urriaga Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water
700 head of cattle
Period of use: April 1st to November 1st
of each year
Date of priority of
appropriation: September 13, 1978


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring, thence conveyed via a 1½ inch pipeline to two 7 feet long by 2 feet deep stockwater troughs where 700 head of cattle water within the NW¼ NW¼ Section 11, T.14N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
