CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ray C. Bedke, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Boulder Well) through a drilled well, windmill, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 36, T.45N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 36 bears S. 14°55'39" W., a distance of 2,073.05 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Winecup, Inc.
Source: Underground (Boulder Well)
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0045 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 425 head of cattle
Period of use: April 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 17, 1987


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 300 feet deep, with a 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill and a 22 feet diameter stockwater trough where 425 head of cattle water within the NW¼, SW¼, Section 36, T.45N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Little Goose Creek Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
