CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 17, T.25N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 17 bears N. 41°02' W., a distance of 4,495.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Henry A. Filippini, Jr. and Marian Filippini

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: August 15, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 500 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1½ H.P. pump and a Flint & Walling motor, thence to one 300 gallon trough and two 200 gallon troughs where 200 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 17, T.25N. R.43E., M.D.B.&M. (Carico Lake Allotment)

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
