CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Peterson Brush Field Well) through a drilled well, windmill, storage tank, and trough for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 12, T.45N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T.46N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 01°18' E., a distance of 9,177.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Petan Company of Nevada, Inc.  
Source: Underground (Peterson Brush Field Well)  
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0178 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: March 10, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 485 feet deep, of unknown diameter, thence conveyed via a windmill to a 5,000 gallon storage tank and stockwater trough where 1,000 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SE¼ and the NE¼ SW¼ of Section 12, T.45N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
