CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Sandra C. Hamilton, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a spring house, booster pump, and pressure tank for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ Section 3, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 3 bears S. 16°44'58" E., a distance of 853.43 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: R.F. Hamilton and Sandra C. Hamilton

Source: Unnamed Spring

Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.085 c.f.s., but not to exceed 28.72 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 7, 1991


Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

7.18 acres in the SE¼ NE¼ Section 3, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
