CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and watering troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 3, T.18N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 3 bears S. 25°01' W., a distance of 869.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bernard G. Damele

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: May 8, 1991


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep with a 6 inch diameter casing via a submersible pump to a 2 feet by 3 feet by 8 feet watering trough where 250 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NW¼ Section 3, T.18N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., located within the Dry Creek Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
