CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Carson River (West Fork) through a diversionary structure and ditches for decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Hansen Dam in the NE corner of the SE¼ NW¼ Section 13, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., by two west side ditches diverting approximately 450 feet south of and above the dam situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Fred H. and Anna E. Dressler  
Source: The Carson River (West Fork)  
Manner of Use: As Decreed  
Amount of appropriation: As decreed, but not to exceed 31.5 acre-feet per season  
Period of use: As Decreed  
Date of priority of appropriation: 1998

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

7.00 acres in the SW¼ SW¼ of Sec. 12, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 562, Carson River Final Decree in United States v. Alpine Land & Reservoir Co., Civil No. D-183 BRT (D. Nevada 1980), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 562.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed as decreed acre-feet per acre per season as decreed from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
