CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Daniel S. Walsworth, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Carson River Channel via the Sagouspe Dam and canals for recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 4, T.19N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 4 bears S. 10°30' E., a distance of 2,563.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
Source: The Carson River Channel
Manner of Use: Recreation
Amount of appropriation: 60.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 16,262.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 30, 1950

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Drain water is diverted by means of the Sagouspe Dam, through the Heppner Canal and the "D" Line Canal to wetlands in the Indian Lakes Marsh Area within the Stillwater Wildlife Management Area for recreational purposes within the following:

Sections 13, 24, 25, 26 and 27, T.20N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M.

Sections 7, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 30 and 31, T.20N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
