CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Brian A. Randall, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the South Fork of Small's (Edgewood) Creek aka Lapham Creek through a diversion dam, headgate box, flume and ditches for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 26, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 26 bears N. 54°30' W., a distance of 2,305.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Park Cattle Company

Source: South Fork of Small's (Edgewood) Creek aka Lapham Creek

Manner of Use: As Decreed

Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.4 acre-feet annually

Period of use: As Decreed

Date of priority of appropriation: *1861

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

Water is developed by means of a diversion dam thence conveyed through a headgate flume and ditches to the place of use hereinafter specifically described:

1.2 acres in the SE¼ of the NE¼ of Seciton 27, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Proof of Appropriation 02421, Certificate 359, of the Smalls (Edgewood) Creek Decree (Case No. 1927, First Judicial District Court, State of Nevada, Douglas County). Therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Proof 02421, Certificate 359.

This certificate waives the requirement that a totalizing meter be installed.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
