CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Steven G. Hamrick, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 2 bears S. 75°03'10" W., a distance of 1,326.45 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sarah E. and Steven G. Hamrick
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Commercial
Amount of appropriation: 0.0891 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.50 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 24, 1992

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 195 feet deep, 8 5/8 inch diameter casing, via a 2 H.P. submersible pump to two pressure tanks, thence through a distribution system to one office building with landscaping for commercial purposes located within the E¼ SE¼ SW¼ SW¼ of Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
