CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Nancy Boardman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, submersible pump, and distribution system for fire protection and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 17, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 17 bears S. 13°34'42" E., a distance of 1,159.15 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Station #4
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Fire Protection and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0009 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.20 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 26, 1984

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, unknown depth, 8 inch diameter casing, via a ½ H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to a firehouse for fire protection and domestic purposes located within a portion of the SE¼ SE¼ Section 17, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
