CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Marian S. Ferrigan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mud Spring through a collection box, pipeline, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 17, T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of Section 16, T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 72° E., a distance of 7,532.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Saval Company
Source: Mud Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 24, 1950

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring via a wood diversion box, thence conveyed through a pipeline to a trough where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NW¼ Section 17, T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Buffalo Valley Grazing Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
