CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Dayton Valley #2) through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 32, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 32 bears N. 13°53'00" E., a distance of 772.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lyon County
Source: Underground (Dayton Valley #2)
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: *0.245 c.f.s., but not to exceed 62.85 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: **April 10, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep, 10 inch diameter casing, via a 5 H.P. submersible pump to a 500,000 gallon and a 1,000,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to the Mark Twain Unit #10 and Daytona Heights Units 1, 2, 3, and 4 Subdivisions, located within the N¼ N¼, portion of the S¼ NE¼ and N¼ SE¼ Section 32, T.17N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 58298, Certificate 14712, and any certificates issued under Permits 58294, 58295, and 58297 shall not exceed 557.83 acre-feet annually for use within Mark Twain Unit 10 (204 units) and Daytona Heights Units 1, 2, 3, and 4 (294 units).

**This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of Permit 29624, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 26660, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26660.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
