CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Nancy Boardman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ Section 18, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 18 bears N. 20°55'45" E., a distance of 2,071.03 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Washoe County
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Recreation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0035 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.50 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 12, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 152 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch diameter casing, via a Goulds 1 H.P. submersible pump and distribution system for the service of restrooms, drinking fountains, and landscaping for recreation and domestic purposes for Crystal Peak Park, located within portions of the E½ of Section 18, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
