CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Louis J. Giraud, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and tank for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 33 bears S. 20°27'29" W., a distance of 5,607.25 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Four G Corporation

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.012 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 400 head of sheep

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 14, 1992


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 8 5/8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Johnston turbine pump, thence conveyed via a pipeline to a 1,200 gallon tank where 300 head of cattle and 400 head of sheep water within the NE¼, NW¼ Section 33, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
