CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Howard R. Weisberger, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 16 bears S. 75°29'18" W., a distance of 1,090.04 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard R. Weisberger

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.5256 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: July 6, 1954

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 150 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, via a pump to a 2,000 gallon pressure tank, thence through a distribution system for domestic purposes located within the SW¼ NW¼, Section 16, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued as a non revocable water right and corrects the permit.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
