CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Eugene Lepire, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 27, T.18N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 27 bears N. 25°36'00" E., a distance of 770.00 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: **Underground**

Manner of Use: **Quasi-Municipal**

Amount of appropriation: **0.2785 c.f.s., but not to exceed
1.415 million gallons annually**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st
of each year**

Date of priority of
appropriation: **March 26, 1982**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 197 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, via a submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to an auto repair and tire shop with landscaping located in Lot 21 of Ramsey Subdivision No. 4 within portions of the E¼ NE¼ Section 27, T.18N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
