CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Merrick Whitesel, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, two submersible pumps, and a distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ Section 7, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 7 bears S. 46°48' E., a distance of 1,510.5 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charles Sargent Irrigation, Inc.
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0014 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *October 14, 1957

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 767 feet deep, with 16 inch casing to 465 feet and 12 inch casing to 767 feet, via a 5 H.P. submersible pump and a 40 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to an office building and equipment yard for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes located within portions of the NE¼ of Section 7, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Permit 48386, which changed the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of a portion of Permit 34764, which changed the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of a portion of Permit 17418, Certificate 5908, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 17418, Certificate 5908.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
