CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from East Squaw Creek #2 through the natural channel and an earthen dam for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.37N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 14 bears N. 65°33' E., a distance of 1,208.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: BSR Associates, Ltd.

Source: East Squaw Creek #2

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.035 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle and 100 horses

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 29, 1982

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is impounded behind an earthen dam measuring 300 feet by 10 feet by 13 feet, where 1,000 head of cattle and 100 horses water within the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 14, T.37N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

Domestic use is estimated at 500 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
