CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Mark Brethauer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ash Canyon Creek (aka Gregory Canyon Creek) through a diversion structure, pipeline, reservoir, treatment plant and distribution system for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 12, T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 12 bears S. 55°53'00" E., a distance of 2,489.0 feet situated in Carson City, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Carson City

Source: Ash Canyon Creek  
(aka Gregory Canyon Creek)

Manner of Use: Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 16.367% of the waters of Ash Canyon Creek

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st  
of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*As Decreed

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a concrete diversion structure, through 3,970 feet of 16 inch diameter pipe to Quill reservoirs, thence through a treatment plant and distribution system to Carson City's service area located within the following:

E½ T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

All of T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

Sections 2, 3, and 4, E½ Section 5, and that portion of the N½ NE¼ of Section 6 which lies within the Carson City limits, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

Sections 31, 32, 33, 34, and 35, W½ of Section 36, and those portions of the E½ of Section 36 which lye within Carson City limits in T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

S½ of Section 34, S½ of Section 35, and that portion of the S¼ NE¼ Section 35 which lies within the Carson City limits, S¼, NE¼ Section 36, and that portion of the SW¼ NW¼ of Section 36 which lies within the Carson City limits, T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.


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\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 47062, which changed the place of use and manner of use of Permit 25546, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the Civil Decree of November 14, 1885 (Kings Canyon Creek and Gregory Canyon Creek aka Ash Canyon Creek) in the District Court of the Second Judicial District of Nevada (Nevers and Bath right), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as the Nevers and Bath right.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
