CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Raymond K. Perra, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 9, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 9 bears N. 87°40'35" E., a distance of 334.40 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Genoa Cemetery Association

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.472 million gallons annually

Period of use: April 2nd to November 9th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 20, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 400 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch diameter casing, via a 7 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to the Genoa Cemetery located within a portion of the NE¼ NE¼ NE¼ Section 9, NW¼ NW¼ NW¼ Section 10, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued supplemental to Proof of Appropriation 02659.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
