CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Roy Owen, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 17, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 17 bears N. 03°05'20" E., a distance of 882.19 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Roy Owen and Nancy Owen
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.24 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 7, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 360 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch diameter casing, via a 5 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to two single family dwellings located within a portion of the NE¼ NW¼ Section 17, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
