CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Frank C. Hulse, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 16, T.5S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 16 bears S. 81°02'06" E., a distance of 2,458.28 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ronald and Delores Cannon
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation
Amount of appropriation: 1.37 c.f.s., but not to exceed 215.35 acre feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 28, 1990

Description of the land to which the water is appurtenant:

21.02 acres in the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 16, T.5S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.
17.74 acres in the SW¼ NE¼ of Section 16, T.5S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.
4.31 acres in the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 16, T.5S., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.
43.07 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the agreement dated April 9, 1991, between Hafen Brothers and Ronald V. Cannon on file in the Office of the State Engineer under Permit 55329.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
