CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Jon L. Bunch, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.32N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 67°19'48" E., a distance of 1,300.00 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada,
Department of Transportation

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.16 c.f.s., but not to exceed
1.60 acre feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st
of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: October 26, 1993


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, via a submersible pump to a 12,000 gallon pressure tank, thence through a distribution system to the Emigrant Pass Highway Maintenance Station located within the SW¼ SE¼ Section 11, NW¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.32N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
