CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Steve Varela, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River (via the Cochran Ditch) through a diversion box for recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ of Section 11, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 11 bears S. 69°15'00" W., a distance of 3,640.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of Reno

Source: Truckee River (via the Cochran Ditch)

Manner of Use: Recreation

Amount of appropriation: 0.77 c.f.s., but not to exceed 122.16 acre feet as decreed

Period of use: As Decreed

Date of priority of appropriation: \*December 1, 1862 (Claim 479)

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from the Truckee River via the Cochran Ditch, to Virginia Lake Park for recreation purposes located within the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 23, NW¼ NW¼, SW¼ NW¼, NW¼ SW¼ Section 24, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of a portion of Claims 476 (drain), 477 (drain) and 479 (direct), Truckee River Final Decree, entered by the U.S. District Court of Nevada, Case in Equity, Docket No. A-3, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 479.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
