CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Geo. T. Toombs, Jr., Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled artesian well and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 4, T.37N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 77° E., a distance of 5,264.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0046 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.33 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 27, 1929


Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.172 acre, Lots 17, 18, and 19, Block V, APN 2-513-01
0.115 acre, Lots 15 and 16, Block V, APN 2-513-01
0.172 acre, Lots 12, 13, and 14, Block V, APN 2-513-10
0.459 total acres in the SE¼ NE¼ and the NE¼ SE¼ of Section 4, T.37N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
