CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gracian Eyroz, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Rock Spring No. 2, an improved spring through a pipeline and pond for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 16, T.28N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 16 bears N. 21°00'00" W., a distance of 657.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: J.L. Hylton

Source: Red Rock Spring No. 2,

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.035 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 5,500 head of sheep

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: December 20, 1929


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring, thence conveyed 10 feet via a 1½ inch pipeline to barrels and a stockwater pond impounded by an earthen dam 50 feet in length, where 5,500 head of sheep water within the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 16, T.28N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Red Rock Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
