CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gracian Eyroz, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Rock Spring No. 3, an improved spring through a pipeline and ponds for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 36, T.28N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 36 bears S. 39°15'00" E., a distance of 520.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: J.L. Hylton
Source: Red Rock Spring No. 3,
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.035 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 5,500 head of sheep
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 20, 1929

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring, thence conveyed 40 feet via a 1½ inch pipeline to four stockwater ponds 20 feet in diameter, impounded by earthen dams, where 5,500 head of sheep water within the SE¼ SE¼ of Section 36, T.28N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., and NW¼ NW¼ of Section 6, T.27N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Red Rock Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
