## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert O. Vaughan, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, windmill and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ Section 24, T.29N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.,  
or at a point from which the NE corner of said  
Section 24 bears N. 08°00'00" E., a distance of  
2,317.82 feet situated in Elko County, State of  
Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water

appropriation: August 28, 1979

## Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by a drilled well, 317 feet deep with an 8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a windmill and a centrifugal pump and 3 horsepower motor, thence conveyed via a 2 inch pipeline to a 4,200 gallon stockwater trough where 350 head of cattle water within the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 24, T.29N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Ruby #8 Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
