CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert A. McLaughlin, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Sun Valley Well) through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 7, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the C¼ corner of said Section 7 bears N. 20°43'58" W., a distance of 267.13 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of North Las Vegas

Source: Underground (Sun Valley Well)

Manner of Use: Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.5 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*March 14, 1946

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 910 feet deep, 16 inch diameter casing, via a 7 stage turbine pump equipped with a 500 H.P. electric motor, thence through a distribution system to the City of North Las Vegas for Municipal purposes located within the following place of use:

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 36; those portions of Sections 6, 7, 8, 17, 21, 27, 28, 34, and 35, lying East of U.S. Highway 95; all in T.19S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1 through 36, inclusive, all in T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 6 and 7; E½ of Section 12; all of Sections 13, 14, and 15; all of Sections 18 through 36, inclusive, all in T.19S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1 through 28, inclusive; and Sections 33, 34, 35, and 36, all in T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1 through 17, inclusive; all of Sections 21, 22, 23, and 24; those portions of Sections 18, 19, and 20, lying East of U.S. Highway 95; the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 26, all in T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

All of those portions of Sections 1, 2, 12, and 13, lying East of U.S. Highway 95, all in T.20S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.


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\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 60958, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 48843, Certificate 11861, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of Permit 11512, Certificate 4406, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 11512, Certificate 4406.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
