CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gary L. Bengochea, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 29, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of Section 19, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 67°00' W., a distance of 9,936.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nevada First Corporation

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: October 2, 1997

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, with a 16 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 1½ horsepower submersible pump, thence conveyed to an 8 feet by 4 feet by 18 inch deep stockwater trough, where 500 head of cattle water within the NE¼ of Section 29, T.38N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
