CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, K.L. Reed, former Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sheep Creek through a diversionary structure and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 26, T.43N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **George T. Flynn**

Source: **Sheep Creek**

Manner of Use: **Irrigation**

Amount of appropriation: ***0.388 c.f.s., but not to exceed 133.91 acre-feet per season**

Period of use: **April 10th to September 30th of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **January 17, 1916**

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

38.8 acres in the W¼ SW¼ of Section 26, T.43N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

***The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and Permit 2514, Certificate 284, shall not exceed 1.094 c.f.s., and 349.33 acre-feet per season for the irrigation of 109.39 acres.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.45 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
