CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Craig Biggart, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 3, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 3 bears N. 55°54'07" E., a distance of 3,116.97 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Don J. and Pamela J. Dubin
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.004 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle and 40 horses
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 4, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well of unknown depth, with a 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a ½ horsepower submersible pump thence conveyed to stockwater troughs where 100 head of cattle and 40 horses water within portions of the NW¼ NE¼ and the SW¼ NE¼ of Section 3, T.12N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
