CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Lee Louden, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Crescent Valley Mineral Hot Springs through a spring box and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows.

SE¼ NW¼ Section 1, T.29N., R 48E., M.D.B.&M , or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said Section 1 bears N. 02°06'16" E., a distance of 1,843.57 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

Name of appropriator: Lee and Nancy Louden
Source: Crescent Valley Mineral Hot Springs
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.022 c.f s., but not to exceed 3.0 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 31, 1994

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use

Water is diverted by means of a 10 feet by 10 feet by 15 feet deep concrete spring box, thence the water is conveyed by pipeline to a swimming pool, hot tubs, cooling pond, fish pond and garden at a 12-unit R V resort and park located within a portion of the N½ of Section 1, T 29N , R 48E., M.D.B &M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
