CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Sally Champion, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T.14N., R 18E., M.D B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 12 bears N. 71°25'39" E., a distance of 271 42 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch diameter casing, via a 3 H P submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to the Spooner Fire Station located within a portion of the E 1/2 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T.14N., R 18E., M D.B &M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 55532, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 11870, Certificate 4122.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
