CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Richard L. Hafen, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 12, T.20S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 12, bears N. 69°49'21" E., a distance of 1,030.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: A. C. A. Jr. Trust, Anthony C. Alosi Jr., Trustee
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Commercial
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.732 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 6, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8 inch diameter casing, via a submersible pump to a pressure tank, thence through a distribution system to two green houses located within the NW¼ NE¼ NE¼ Section 12, T.20S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., for commercial purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
