CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest E. Muller, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 24, T.35N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of said Section 24, bears S. 40°13'34" W., a distance of 1,711.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. J. Burrus and Verna L. Burrus  
Source: Underground  
Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0663 c.f.s., but not to exceed 48.0 acre-feet annually  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: \*December 12, 1963

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

12.0 acres in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 24, T.35N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 45775, Certificate 14165, which changed the place of use of Permit 32707, which changed the place of use of Permit 29601, which changed the place of use of Permit 28518, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 24097, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 21680, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 21680.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
