## CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James T. Anspach, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well #4), through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 15, T.14S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 15 bears S.87°35'00"E., a distance of 2,500.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.**

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: See page two

\*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 27904, Certificate 9027 and any certificates issued under Permits 56477, 56478, 56479, 56480, 56482, 56485, 56486, 56487, 56489, 56677, 65136, 65137, 65138 and 65139 shall not exceed 2,941.471 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 588.29 acres within the 727.5 acres as described on page 2.

\*\*This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of Permit 50976, which changed the place of use of Permit 30729, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 30729.

This certificate is issued subject to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement dated July 24, 1985, Case No. A 218066 in the Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, Meadow Valley Farm Lands Irrigation Company, et al. v. Nevada Power Company, et al.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.
