CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Jim Usher, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unimproved spring for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.11N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 36, bears S. 14°30'00" E., a distance of 2,185.00 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Berry Spring
Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	November 3, 1993

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.25 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.11N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
