CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton III, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.39N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23, bears N. 71°03'00" E., a distance of 621.4 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Paradise Valley Fire District
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	0.67 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*December 6, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 140 feet deep, 8 5/8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a 15 H.P. submersible pump, thence to the Paradise Ranchos Road Volunteer Fire House, with two stand pipes for truck loading and a hydrant, for fire protection and domestic use, located within the N¼ NE¼ NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.39N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
