CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jan Afflerbach, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cold Creek through a hydraulic ram and pipeline for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 36, T.17S., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¹/₄ corner of said Section 36 bears N. 44°32'18" E., a distance of 697.95 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Jan Afflerbach
Source:	Cold Creek
Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0015 c.f.s. , but not to exceed 1.08 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	July 12, 1995

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Cold Creek by means of a hydraulic ram, through a ¾ inch and ½ inch pipe to a storage tank, thence to a row of olive trees located within the E¹/₄ NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 36, T.17S., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
