CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jim Usher, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹ SE¹ Section 7, T.14N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 12, T.14N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 80°35'00" W., a distance of 9,301.50 feet situated in Carson City, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source: **Unnamed Spring**
Manner of Use: **Stockwater**
Amount of appropriation: **0.00774 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle**
Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**
Date of priority of appropriation: **September 9, 1988**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water from an unimproved spring is used to water 250 head of cattle, within the NW¹ SE¹ of Section 7, T.14N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
