CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hankins Creek, through dams, ditches and headgates for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 29, T.29N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 29 bears S. 36°38'35" E., a distance of 392.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: State of Nevada, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Division of State Lands
Source: Hankins Creek
Manner of Use: Irrigation
Amount of appropriation: *6.28 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2,667.58 acre-feet per season
Period of use: March 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 24, 1976

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

1,108.01 acres in Franklin Lake Bed, T.28N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.
1,191.59 acres in Franklin Lake Bed, T.29N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M.
2,299.60 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 1.16 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
