CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dwight L. Smith, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well #4), through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for recreation (golf course) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 36 bears S. 47°56'01" W., a distance of 141.27 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Bellagio
Source:	Underground (Well #4)
Manner of Use:	Recreation (golf course)
Amount of appropriation:	0.3118 c.f.s., but not to exceed 74.73 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*February 5, 1949

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 520 feet deep, 16 inch diameter casing, via a turbine pump equipped with a 40 H.P. motor, thence through a distribution system to the Shadow Creek Golf Course located within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36, T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 62423, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 60730, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 58760, Certificate 13976, which changed the point of diversion and manner of use of Permit 30699, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 12809, Certificate 5144, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12809, Certificate 5144.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
