CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Coyote Spring, through a spring box and pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 20, T.43N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 20 bears S. 12°40'49" E., a distance of 1,230.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Coyote Spring
Manner of Use:	Stockwater
Amount of appropriation:	0.031 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	April 10, 1979

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted by means of a redwood box 3-foot by 3-foot by 3-foot, to an open ditch, thence water is impounded behind a small earth dam where 1,000 head of cattle water within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 20, T.43N., R.58E., M.D.B.&M., in the Deeth Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
