CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Brandon A. Potts, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pine Spring, through a spring box, pipeline and troughs for wildlife watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 28, T.27S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the U.S. Geological Survey Triangulation Station "Bell", bears S. 52°45'14" E., a distance of 47,401.79 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted by means of a spring box, through a 1 inch PVC pipe to three troughs where wildlife water within the NW¼ NE¼ Section 28, T.27S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
