CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Harold L. and Patricia L. Woolery, Agents, have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 14, bears N. 08° 27' 46" E., a distance of 1,958.50 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Woolery Family Trust
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Commercial
Amount of appropriation:	0.029 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.316 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	June 28, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 160 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 5 H.P. submersible pump, thence to a livestock auction facility located on Assessor's Parcel Number 07-131-21, being within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
